

## Using Compscore2 with Bridge Tabs

Make sure that the PC and tablets are attached to the wi- fi.

- 1 In C:\Compscore2\Bridgemates create a directory "Events"
- 2 Open Compscore2
- 3 In Set-up, "Scoring Device Options"

Scoring Device Settings

Type of tabletop scoring device being used: Bridge Scorer / Bridgetabs

Full path and filename of Bridgemate Control Software or equivalent (BCS): C:\BOS\BridgeScorer\BSControl.exe [Browse]

Folder for BWS files: C:\Compscore2\Bridgemates\Events [Browse]

Let Compscore2 manage the scoring device settings (where applicable)

General Features | Extras | Some of these features are not relevant to devices other than Bridgemates.



- Automatically close BCS at end of session


- a) Set path to Bridgemate Control Software to " C:\BOS\BridgeScorer\BSControl.exe"
- b) Set Folder for BWS files: to " C:\Compscore2\Bridgemates\Events"

4. Close Compscore2
5. Open BOS
6. Select Event screen and create new event



Hold down the Shift Key and Select "Start Scoring". **You only do this first time you start BOS.** Once you have ticked the remember button no need to hold shift key when you select Start Scoring.

Select CompScore2 and click on “remember this choice” Then click “OK”.





Compscore2 will open. So select New Session.

Define your movement and then click on “Choose non-standard name and/or location for BWS file.”

Then click “Change”.


The following window opens up.






Type in your event name you created in step 6. Then click Open


You will be returned to the session Setup Screen. Now click apply and you will see the confirmation screen. Click "Yes".



Now you see this screen. Click “Launch”.




You will now see the following screen:



Choose Game Settings (these can be set as Defaults).

Click "Save".



You will see the tables and rounds appear.

Then click the Green Start Button. This will start the BT Server.

On the Tablets you should now see the green start button touch it and communication will start.
